

MARKET OVERVIEW

Holly Springs, North Carolina

Established in 1877, The Town of Holly Springs is located in the southwest region of Wake County between Apex and Fuquay-Varina. Once described as a "deserted village" at the end of the Civil War, the town has grown rapidly in recent years with the population increasing from 1,000 in 1990 to 25,000 present day. Close proximity to the famed "Research Triangle Park", North Carolina's dominate economic engine, has only added to Holly Springs's appeal as a home for transplants and natives alike.

Holly Springs has numerous cultural and recreational facilities including the Holly Springs Library & Cultural Arts Center, Hunt Recreation Center, Bass Lake Park and Ting Park. There are 7 public schools in Holly Springs, all which are part of the Wake County School System. In 2012, Holly Springs High School was recognized as "one of the best public high schools in the United States" by the Washington Post.

Many businesses have facilities in Holly Springs. Seqirus, a flu vaccine manufacturer, is the town's largest employer. Other major employers include GMA Supply, OFM, Inc., Rovisys, Pierce Group Benefits and Rex Healthcare.
