Charlotte, North Carolina

Charlotte is the center of the nation's fifth largest urban region. This is startling considering that Charlotte, a mid-sized city with a population of 680,828, is the largest city within the region. Several major airlines serve the Charlotte-Douglas International Airport, providing non-stop and direct daily flights to nearly 160 domestic cities. Charlotte is first and foremost a banking city. With \$2 trillion in assets, it is the second largest financial center in the nation, behind only New York. One of the nation's largest banks, Bank of America, is headquartered here. Wells Fargo also continues to have a very large presence.

Very strong national restaurant sales


Recent completion of I-485 (2015) has spurred growth in the area (multifamily, retail & office)


Significant daytime pop. with surrounding office and manufacturing on W. T. Harris Blvd


