MARKET OVERVIEW

Lincolnton, North Carolina

Incorporated in 1785, Lincolnton is the second oldest town west of the Catawba River. Lincolnton offers the opportunity to visit numerous Revolutionary War sites, and a stroll down historic tree-lined streets and historic homes from the nineteenth century.

Ideally situated in the foothills between Charlotte NC and the Appalachian Mountains, Lincolnton is accessible to big city amenities/entertainment while retaining a smalltown charm, steeped in history and located just minutes from two major Interstates: I-40 & I-85. US Highway 321 runs through Lincolnton; beginning near Savannah, GA and extending Northwest into Tennessee, connecting I-95 to I-85. Highway 321's path include notable South Carolina markets: Columbia, Chester, York and North Carolina: Gastonia, Hickory & Boone.

Part of the Carolina Thread Trail, the Cloninger Rail Trail passes through the heart of downtown Lincolnton and connects three city parks. Each June, Lincolnton celebrates its pivotal role in the American Revolution with the Battle of Ramsour's Mill "Battle Weekend" event. The patriot victory is commemorated each year with a living history weekend of Revolutionary War reenactments and music, period cooking, firearms demonstrations, battle site tours and a wreath-laying ceremony at the mass gravesite by the Sons & Daughters of the American Revolution.










SITE PLAN
